The curriculum also included an ongoing child assessment and evaluation process and a parent/family engagement strategy. In addition, Dr. Sullivan led the Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS) process at five early childhood centers and supported accreditation efforts through the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC).
